## **Apr 8 - Jun 24 2018**



Our Easter to summer period starts with 2 weeks looking at two key disciplines of the Christian life. How do we grow in our knowledge of the Bible and practise prayer in our personal lives? This will be done by several friends sharing on how they practise these disciplines.



There then follows a four-part series on the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is not an "it" to be analysed, a theological topic for erudite discussion and intellectual speculation. He is God, to be known and experienced, to be loved and enjoyed, to be worshipped and obeyed, to be held in awe. More than our minds need to be changed as we study what the Bible teaches about him. We ought to help one another to be filled with him and his passion to glorify the Lord Jesus and God the Father.

This period also includes a 'one off' talk on the Reformation which is topical having just passed 500 years since its beginning. How did it start, how did it spread? Even a Trongate bell could proclaim "Lord, let Glasgow Flourish by the preaching of the word"? Is it all over, or is it too soon to say?

There is also a talk on 'Loneliness' as well as another of our occasional series on 'Fruitfulness on The Front Line'.
